February 24, 2000

We, the members of the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) and the Kansas Consulting Engineers (KCE) Liaison Committee, agree to the following objectives, processes, and action items:

1. Taking the lead in meeting the goals and objectives of the Partnering Agreement and in implementing its action plans.
2. Resolving issues as prioritized by identifying appropriate teams or task groups and assigning specific charges and deadlines; implementing adopted solutions.
3. Reinforcing ethics to KCE/KDOT engineers through partnering activities.
4. Taking the partnering message home to employees.

6. Fostering mutual education and beneficial communication by having Consultant staff work with KDOT staff, and vice versa.
