



COMPUTATION FOR ACEC of KANSAS DUES

INSTRUCTIONS & NOTES

1. Determine your man-hours for work done in Kansas for the most recent calendar year.

“Work done in Kansas” means work on projects located in Kansas, regardless of where the work force addressing that project may be based; and, “work force” is interpreted to include all labor activities, technical and/or non-technical, directly and indirectly supporting projects in Kansas.

2. Complete the man-hours schedule up to your total man-hours or two hundred thousand (200,000), whichever is less. The equals your base amount. The maximum base amount for ACEC of Kansas dues is \$3,600.00.
3. Enter your calculated Base Amount on the top line of the “Dues Computation” column, or \$200.00 whichever is greater. The minimum base amount for ACEC of Kansas dues is \$200.00.
4. Multiply your calculated or minimum annual dues by the established multiplier and enter the result on the line “Annual Dues”.
5. Divide your Annual Dues by four and enter the result on the line “Quarterly Dues”. This is the amount you will be billed for ACEC of Kansas dues at the beginning of the next quarter.
