Any requirement to submit costs or hours (actual or estimated) prior to final selection will render a project ineligible. A copy of the original project request for qualifications must be submitted with the application. If hired directly under a sole source relationship, please indicate this in lieu of the copy of the request for qualifications. *Entries that do not contain documentation or confirmation of a pure QBS procurement process will not be considered.*
- 5. Contribution of the project to the city and community will be of great importance.
- 6. Size and cost of the project will not be the determining factors in selecting winners.
- 7. Pictures of the completed project will be of great assistance to the judges.
