1. Awards will be made according to population. One award is made in each of the following categories:

- 1. Under 10,000
- 2. 10,000 and above

2. Projects to be considered must have been substantially completed between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023.

3. Any construction project which involved PUBLIC funds will be eligible.

4. **PLEASE NOTE:** In keeping with our mission to promote the use of Qualifications Based Selection (QBS) in selection of professional design services, entries must have been procured using a pure QBS system. Any requirement to submit costs or hours (actual or estimated) prior to final selection will render a project ineligible. A copy of the original project request for qualifications must be submitted with the application. If hired directly under a sole source relationship, please indicate this in lieu of the copy of the request for qualifications. *Entries that do not contain documentation or confirmation of a pure QBS procurement process will not be considered.*

- 5. Contribution of the project to the county and community will be of great importance.
- 6. Size and cost of the project will not be the determining factors in selecting winners.
- 7. Pictures of the completed project will be of great assistance to the judges.
